




Create blend contract from existing straight contract

To create a blend contract from an existing straight contract, follow these steps:


Step 1: Search and add a blend to your cart by clicking the cart icon. You can also add multiple products by selecting the checkbox next to the product then clicking '**Add to order**'.

To learn how to search for products or create a blend, go to the **Product Search QRG**.






Step 2: Choose the validity period of the offer, quantity, and phasing for each product.





Step 3: Click 'Save Changes' then click 'View draft offer'.




Step 4: Fill in your details.




Step 5: Click the add contract icon.




Step 6: Select the checkbox of the existing straight contracts you wish to apply.




Step 7: Click 'Select'.
